Statement from the Christian Brothers Oceania – William Houston

The Christian Brothers Oceania Province today released the following statement after the sentencing of a former brother, William Houston, in Melbourne today.

The charges with which this man has been found guilty and sentenced today are shocking.

That any young person placed in our care has been abused as these children were by this man is a matter of great regret and remorse for all Christian Brothers.

To those who suffered as a result of his actions, you have our unreserved apology.

The Christian Brothers Oceania views these actions as a deplorable betrayal of the trust of innocent children and their families.

The protection and safety of children is the highest priority of the Christian Brothers Oceania.

We cooperate fully with any and all investigations into these matters and we strongly urge any person holding evidence of criminal conduct to take that to the Police.
